 Develop bioeconomy solutions for the sustainability agenda



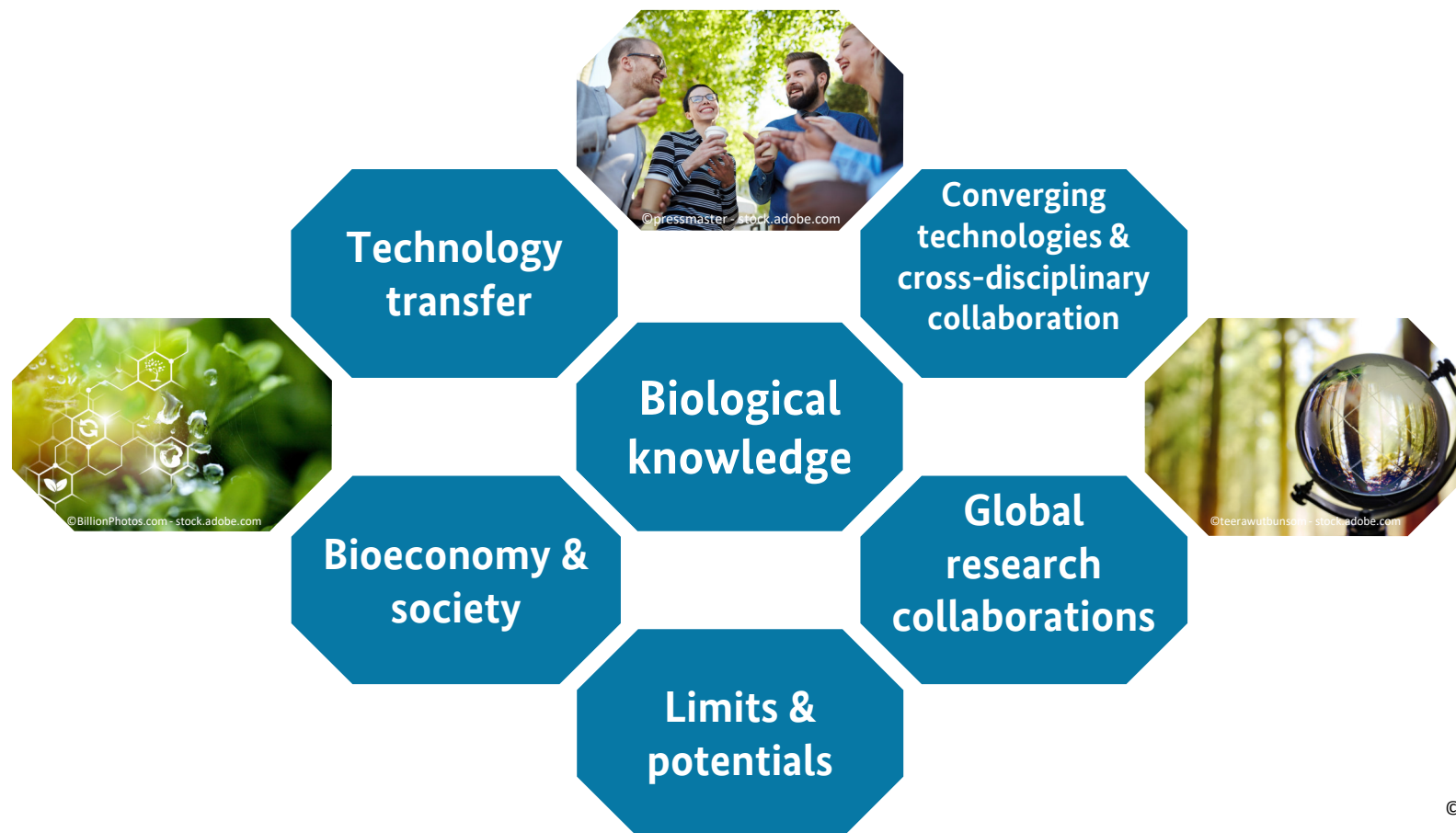
The National Bioeconomy Strategy

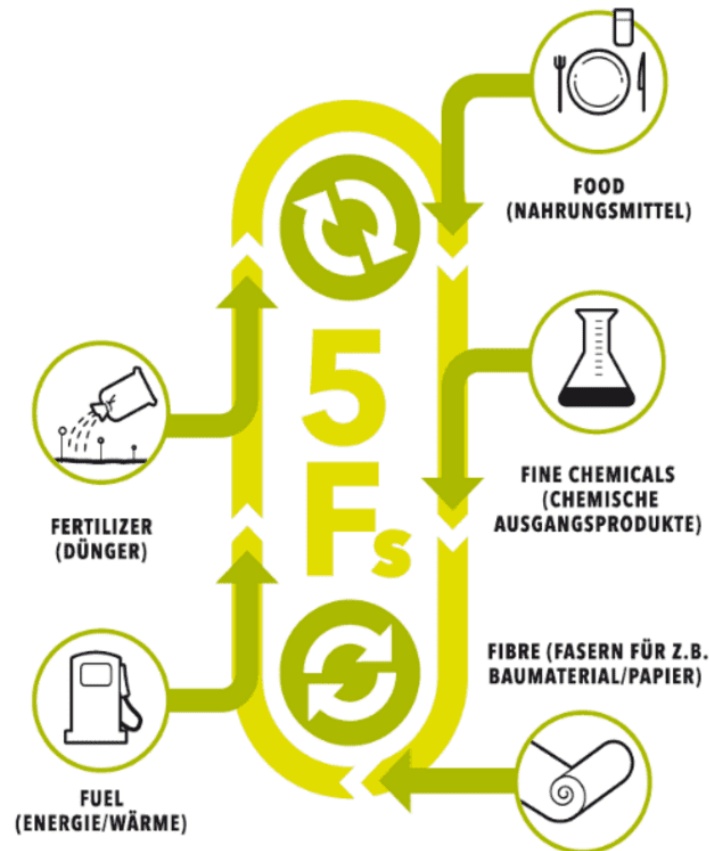

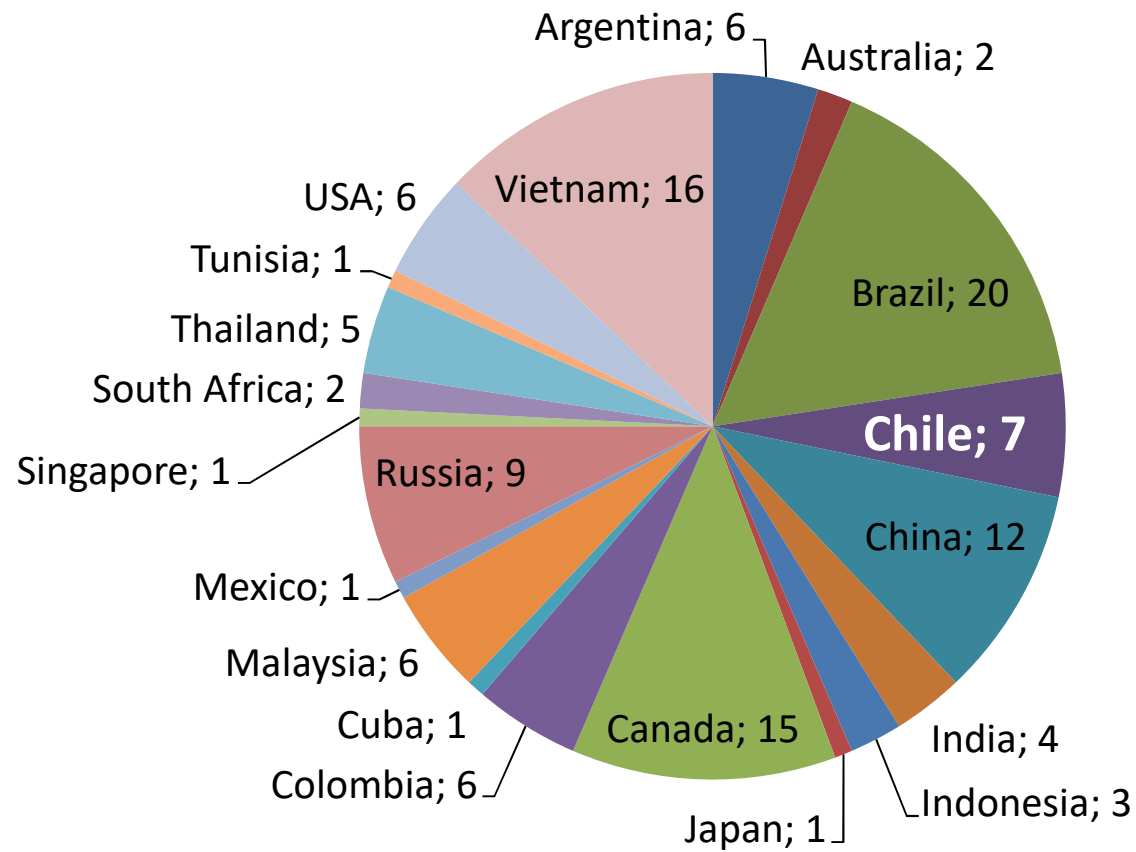

Science Year on Bioeconomy

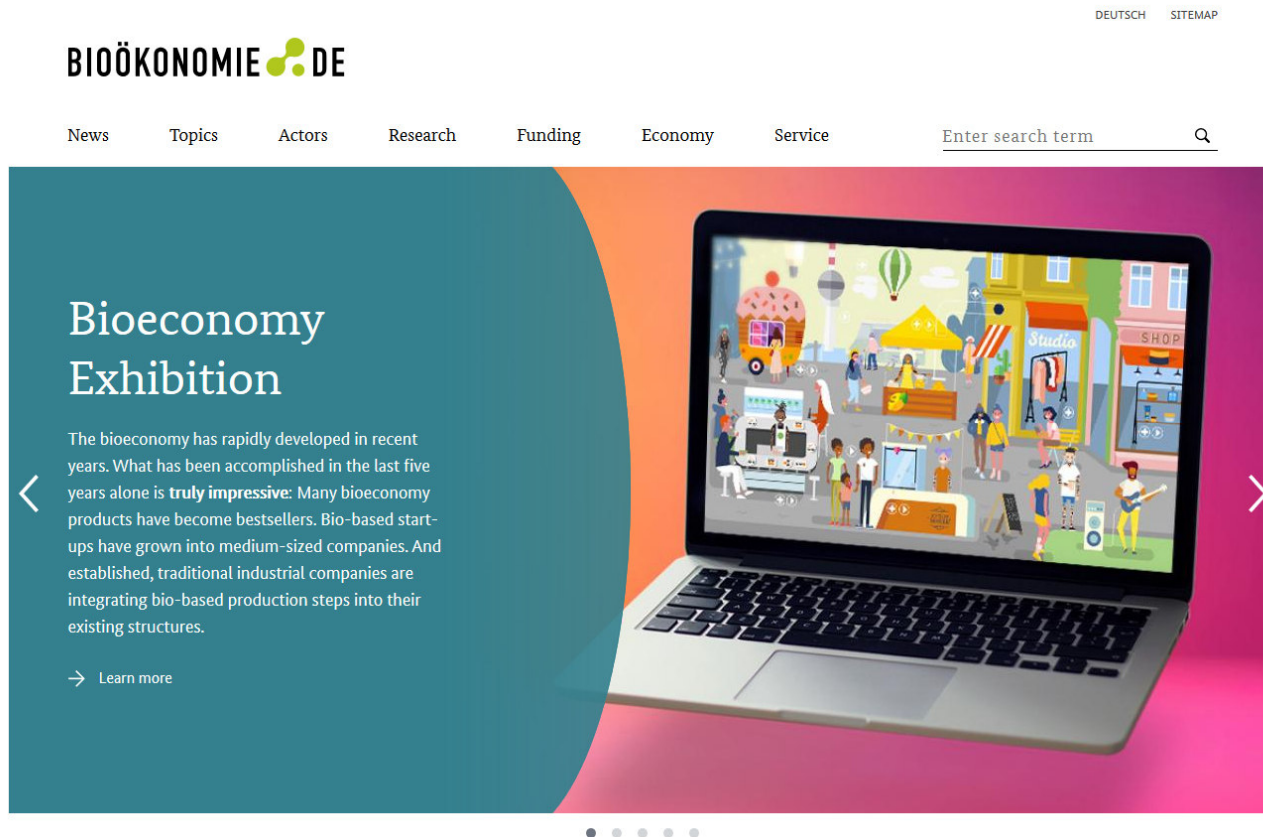
We want to make the bioeconomy better known and more tangible by:
